Position overview (Assistant Site Manager)

This role involves hands-on work across our high-end residential projects — extensions, refurbishments, and loft conversions. You'll work alongside our site manager and wider team to deliver each home to the highest standard, on time and with pride.

We are seeking someone with experience in 1st and 2nd fix carpentry, but is happy to undertake a multi-trades role. Some examples of work that would be required (but not limited to) are below;

- With support from the site manager, managing labourers in strip out and site preparation sections of a project
- All aspects of 1st fix carpentry
 - Pitching roofs
 - Studwork (structural and non)
 - o Floor joists and laying subfloor
 - o Ply lining
- Insulating (with loft roll, PIR and/or acoustic slab)
- Plasterboard tacking and dot & dab
- Assisting team with installing structural steelwork
- All aspects of 2nd fix carpentry
 - o Skirtings and architraves
 - Kitchen/bedroom fitting
 - Hanging doors (both sliding and standard)
 - o Constructing and installing bespoke media walls or storage solutions
- General residential building

What You'll Bring to the Team

- Minimum 10 years' experience in residential construction or a specific trade (e.g. carpentry or general building)
- Own tools and transport
- CSCS card (preferred)
- Strong eye for detail and finish

Hours

The role will be full-time and the working hours are 8am - 4pm Monday to Friday (however we do expect you on site before 8am to take part in a team briefing lasting c15mins). There is optional overtime and weekend work available - subject to workload.



Hierarchy

The company is owned and operated by father son duo, Mike & Isaac Maynard-Smith. They head up overall project management and sales/business development.

Our core site team currently consists of our site manager, two skilled labourers and one unskilled labourer. This role will sit between site manager and skilled labour.

We have a large team of sub contractors who support the rest of the functions (tilers, plumbers, electricians etc).

Format

The successful candidate will be a self employed contractor and will be CIS registered.

We will provide you with company branded workwear, (t shirts, jumpers, gilets and hats) you are expected to supply and wear your own PPE and appropriate smart (black) work trousers/shorts.

Location

Most of our work is within Gidea Park, Hornchurch, Upminster, and surrounding areas of Havering, but we do extend to East London (Ilford, Chigwell, Loughton etc) and Essex (Leigh-on-Sea, Chelmsford etc). You will be expected to travel directly to and from site each day.

Salary

Depending on the successful candidate's experience, we are offering between £180-£200 per day plus performance related bonuses per project (expect 4-5 projects per year).

As we continue to grow, there will be opportunities to take on more responsibility and progress within the team.
